

Concept:

"The Bridge Center – WAY to transitional justice and social cohesion in Lebanon for studies and research" is envisioned as a permanent research center dedicated to promoting civil peace, fostering social cohesion, and providing a platform for addressing historical grievances and conflicts. The hub aims to be a dynamic space that adapts to evolving events and contributes to the development of comprehensive policies for sustainable peace in the nation.

Objectives:

1. Promote Transitional Justice:

- Research on Historical Injustices: The hub will engage in thorough research to document and analyze historical injustices and conflicts in Lebanon. This involves identifying key events, understanding the root causes, and assessing the impact on different communities.
- Truth and Reconciliation Processes: Develop and advocate for mechanisms that facilitate truth and reconciliation processes.

Action plan

1. Year 1: Establishment and Foundation
